This spring, Robert is teaching a number of Perspectives classes throughout the Midwest, which is an excellent opportunity to teach about the needs of God's world and how best to participate in missions. Robert is doing a lot of travel now, so pray for Laurie with the 4 kids. On March 18-19, Robert will be leading the logistics for a conference for Chinese believers who are preparing to return to China for ministry there. What an amazing opportunity! This is the first ever conference here in North America to prepare new believers to return to China. We are hoping for 100 Chinese citizens. Pray that they will learn, network, and grow, and that through this many more Chinese will come to Christ.

It is an exciting and busy time for us here in Asia. We have just launched a monthly Artist Network connecting with like-minded creative's around the city who want to make an impact in this nation for the glory of God. We are also preparing for a guest performer: teacher/actor traveling here from Canada to perform stories of hope and redemption at this years first ILLUME. We have seen great doors open for him to share at both local and international fellowships across our city on how to be effective communicators of the gospel through the art of telling your story. We are struggling a bit with this ILLUME as our normal theater has just fallen through so we are scrabbling to find a new venue. Please pray that we would find a new venue quickly and would have favor with this new venue. Ask that our team would have eyes to see our Father's path laid out before us.

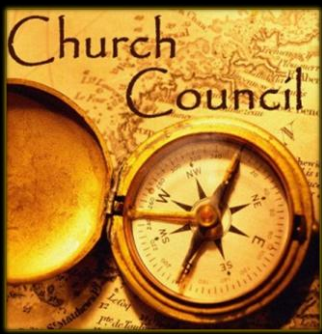
