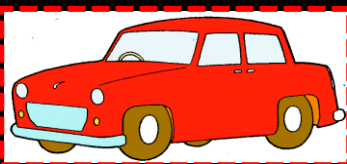
## HOLY SCRAP

Many Chinese become Christians in the US, but there are limited resources to help prepare Chinese who have become Christians to return to China. Proper preparation is essential so that they can make an impact for the Kingdom there. Leaders from OMF International, ISI, Inter-Varsity, Campus Crusade and China Outreach Ministries met in our office last month to plan the first ever conference to help prepare Chinese students to return home. It will be held in March here in Wheaton, and I will be overseeing the local logistics of the conference. The vision is that every returnee will return with a sense of calling and mission, enabled to continue a walk of faithfulness, equipped to integrate into the body of Christ in China, and prepared to withstand the inevitable challenges to all of the above. Please pray for this conference!

The Hardins work with Frontiers, a ministry working to bring Christ to the Muslim world. Our "faith goal" is to send teams of missionaries to 50 Muslim unreached people groups in five years. As far as we know, not one of these 50 Muslim groups has even a single Christian missionary living among them. With God's help we've engaged 8 of these groups so far—providing an opportunity for some to hear the gospel for the very first time. Please pray that more teams would be raised up and that God would bless this important initiative.

Just recently he interrupted his lesson to ask me, "Why is everyone looking for love?" I was able to share with him about why people the world around are searching for the same thing; love and who love is. The next week Nick started his next semester of school which always begins with military training where students are told not to consider such ideas and are reminded of communist ideologies. In the past I have gotten students back from "training week" who's curious thinking is shutdown and it takes weeks or more to get back our trust. Please ask that I have wisdom in our future lessons and ask that God will continue to answer the questions swimming around in his heart and that Nick would come to full knowledge and belief in the one who is love.

Our testimony provoked a new wave of repentance in Bulgarian believers. Even though Bulgaria is a poor country and we cannot expect financial support from BG churches, we believe that we have to spend time sharing because churches in Bulgaria keep us in their prayers.
