We want to thank God for His great glory and to share some of the wonders with you to rejoice with us and be encouraged in faith.

Events in the Middle East, including the recent overthrow of Libya's Muammar Qadhafi, have been much in the news. What might happen if believers around the world used news reports as a **springboard for prayer**? For example, in response to news from Libya we can pray...

- for restoration of peace
- for a new government which will allow greater access to the gospel
- that the difficulties of recent months would stir spiritual hunger in the hearts of Muslims
- for comfort and healing in the face of great suffering.

Let's allow current news to prompt us to intercede for these Muslims whom God longs to reconcile to himself.

Last 3 months we focused all our energy working with the Gipsy people here in Turkey. The culmination of our previous work with them was getting 4 of them to Bulgaria, where they could spend personal time with Bulgarian Gipsy Christians and learn the Gospel more clearly. One of them is known as the mayor of the Gipsy neighborhood and the other 3 guys are missionaries. It wasn't easy because Gipsys are not welcome anywhere and respectively we met a lot of difficulty on the BG border. Even though all of them had a BG visa the Bulgarian border police took them and sent them back to Turkey. Finally after 5 hours, arrangements and negotiations were made and our guests were allowed in. We spent 7 days among Gipsy Christians in Bulgaria and they were so strongly touched by God. Me and my family helped them with translation and teaching. I hope God can open new doors for us working among Gipsy people. There is only one Gipsy Church in all of Izmir, Turkey. They are very poor. Most of them work at the garbage dump and some of them live there, but God promises that He will care for them. Ps 113:5-8

BACK TO SCHOOL LUNCHEON



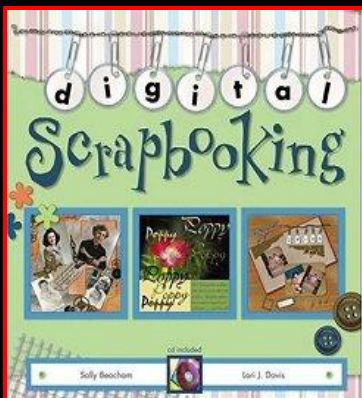

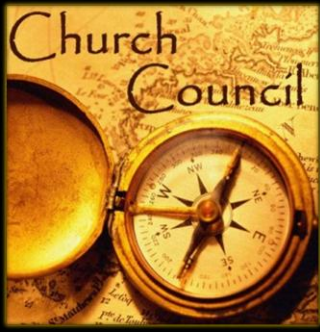
